



Corrigendum: European Migration Network publication "Key Figures on Immigration 2019"

Page **22** text: Figure regarding Somalia is incorrect. It should read as follows:

*In 2019, the largest group of applicants was again Iraqi nationals by a large margin (1,431, of which 1,134 were subsequent applications), followed by Somali nationals (**483**, of which 340 were subsequent applications). The countries of origin that accounted for the largest number of new asylum seekers were Turkey (388, of which 364 were new) and Russia (336, of which 292 were new).*

Page **22** graph **Asylum seekers 1 January–31 December 2019** should read as follows:

- Iraq 1431
- Somalia 483
- Turkey 388
- Afghanistan 364
- Russian Federation 336

Page **23** graph **Unaccompanied minors, 1 January–31 December 2019** should read as follows:

- Iraq 19
- Somalia 18
- Afghanistan 14
- Syria 8
- Angola 6
