Take your career to new heights. Become a sheet metal worker!

You'll get to work with your hands, use your creativity and solve problems. And as a qualified sheet metal worker, you can be sure there are plenty of jobs and a good salary.

A genuine craft

Construction sheet metal workers cover the roofs and exterior walls of buildings with plating and install rainwater systems and safety devices. The job may also include painting, cleaning and clearing snow from roofs as well as fitting additional insulation. Work on the construction site is combined with processing sheet metal back in the workshop. It's a flexible profession, combining fresh air and the best views with high standards on function and appearance. Not just anyone can be a good sheet metal worker. It's a profession to be proud of.

Salary and career

On completion of an upper secondary school course, the entry salary is around SEK 20,500 a month. After a few years in the industry, vocational examination and certification, the average salary rises to around SEK 33,600 a month.

You can work in Sweden or overseas

There are lots of opportunities for qualified sheet metal workers all over the country. Swedish construction sheet metal workers are also in great demand overseas.

How to become a sheet metal worker

There are five different training paths for becoming a sheet metal worker.

1. Building and Construction programme

You can choose the construction sheet metal orientation in Year 2 of upper secondary school.

2. Company-based upper secondary school course

Run by certain upper secondary schools which do not have their own sheet metal orientation. Additional training is provided by the industry school, PVF Teknikcentrum, in Katrineholm.

3. Company apprenticeships

Employment and training at companies. Additional training is provided by the industry school, PVF Teknikcentrum, in Katrineholm.

4. Labour market training

Unemployed people can do training via the Swedish Public Employment Service. 17 weeks at a company and 23 weeks at the industry school, PVF Teknikcentrum, in Katrineholm.

5. Komvux training

Adults can get a grant to study towards becoming a sheet metal worker at upper secondary schools with a construction sheet metal orientation.

Demand is high!

There is big demand for more qualified construction sheet metal workers in the industry both now and in the future.

The role of PVF Yrke & Utbildning is to inform, recruit, and create training opportunities so that more young people can discover the sheet metal profession.
