
Membership benefits

Education in the welding industry

Education in the welding industry consists of degree & continuing education as well as different qualifications.

Expertise acquired by international qualification education in welding is proved by a large theory exam and practical qualification exams. In Finland, qualification education is organized by approximately 40 training bodies. The WSF Governing Board manages the international qualification education system in welding in Finland. WSF developes the educational possibilities of training bodies by conducting first-timer, renewal and follow up audits.



International education

Since the beginning, Finland has actively taken part in developing educational programs and utilizing them in different areas of welding. The central purpose, to unify the education and to harmonize the expertise, has been filled with international qualification education. The international IIW/EWF education in welding has set an example for other European education when it comes to harmonizing.
